- Minimum age 21
- Must have a valid US Driver's License for at least one year
- No violent felonies
- Must be able to read, write, and understand the English language

### QUALIFICATIONS FOR AVIATION MAINTENANCE:

- High school student or graduate with at least a 2.0 GPA
- Self-motivated and a self starter
- Likes working with your hands

### RESPONSIBILITIES OF AVIATION MAINTENANCE:

- Accomplishes aircraft lubrications and cleaning aircraft structures and components
- Opening aircraft access panels for inspection and/or maintenance
- Applying corrosion preventative compound to aircraft structures
- Closing aircraft access panels areas following maintenance inspection after receiving the appropriate clearance to close per AAR and customer procedures

## AVIATION TECH PROGRAM

This course introduces the theory and basic skills needed to assist aircraft sheet metal mechanics and to perform aircraft sheet metal modification and repair. Students develop skills in pattern layout, drilling, riveting, sheet metal bending, simple repairs, safely use basic hand and machine tools, identify basic material and hardware, common fastener installation/removal, corrosion removal/treatment and print reading used in aircraft maintenance. Students in the program will receive:

**Opportunities:** Learn from professionals to get an in-depth education

### GET CERTIFIED:

### REQUIREMENTS:

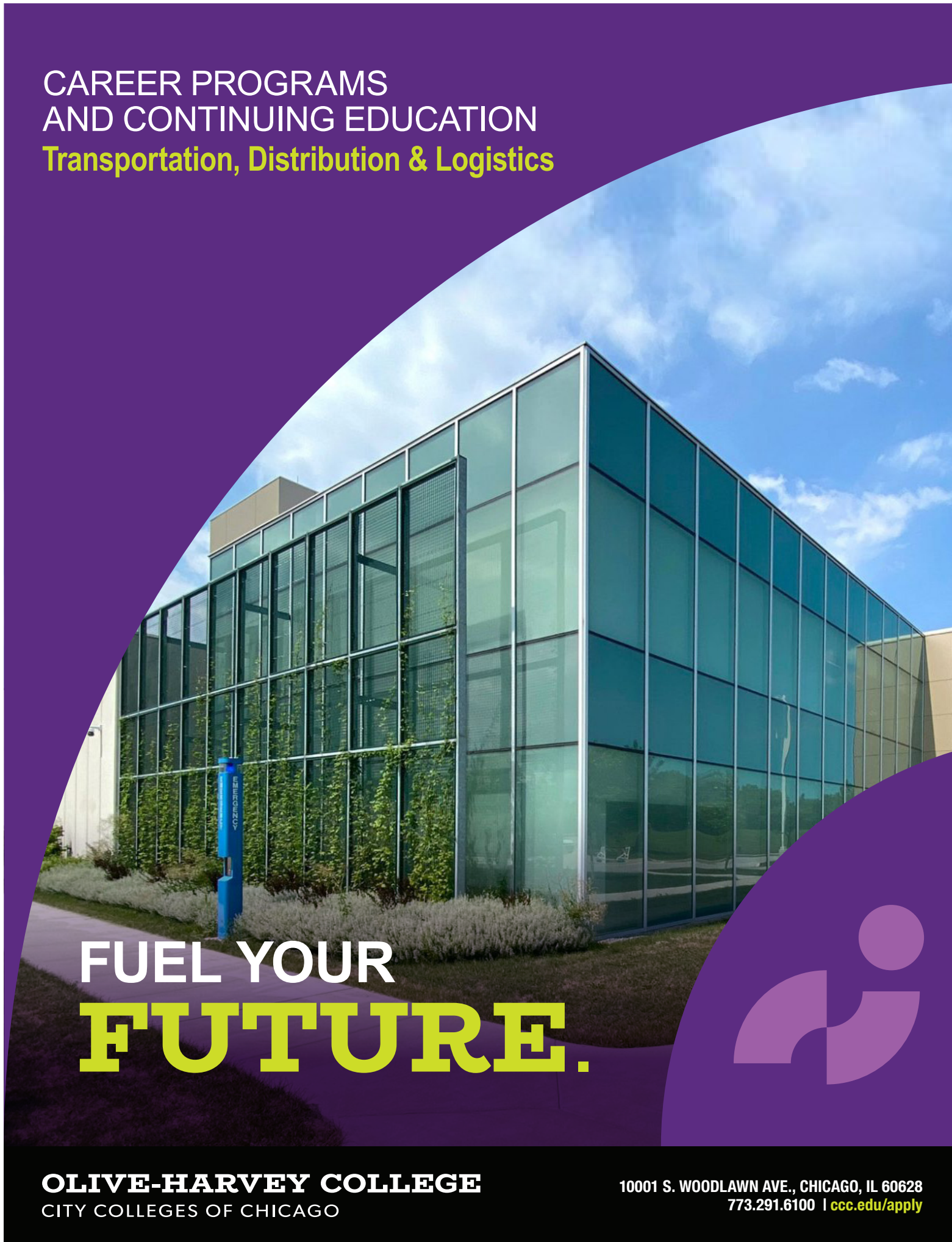
- Must be 18 years or older

### Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- All applicants interested in registering MUST attend an informational session
- Must be at least 21 years old at the time of registration
- Have a valid Illinois Driver's License
- Have a good driving record
  - ▶ Provide a Court-Purposed Motor Vehicle Report (MVR). This report can be obtained from the Illinois Secretary of State (cost \$12)
- Pass an Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) physical exam (including drug screen)
  - ▶ ALL students subject to random drug and alcohol testing
- Must be able to read, write and understand the English language

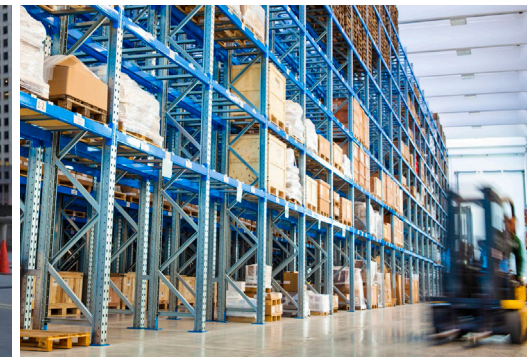

## FORKLIFT OPERATOR TRAINING

### TRAINING PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Must be at least 18 years old at the time of registration
- Must have a valid State Identification Card or Driver's License (Driver's License not required for course)
- Must be able to read, write and understand the English language
- Must attend all 3½ scheduled days of class & pass the National Safety Council Exam to obtain course credit

## AUTOMOTIVE TECHNOLOGY

### ASSOCIATE DEGREE | CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS

The Automotive Technology Certificate programs provide the necessary foundation and practical experience to pursue entry-level positions that meet the changing demands of the auto industry. The AAS Program equips students the technical skills essential to employment in the field of maintenance technology, auto body care, chassis, diesel, and power train, leading to employment in service, maintenance, and areas of technological specialty such as detailing, auto body paint and refinishing, as well as management occupations or self-employment.

### PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

Olive-Harvey College's Automotive Technology Program consists of a Basic Certificate, Advanced Certificate and Associate Degree Programs. Eligibility for English 101 and Math 90 or 98 are required. High school diploma or GED required. Must be at least 18 years old at the time of registration.

- Basic Certificate - 5 Courses (20 credit hours): AUTOTEC 101, 103, 104, 109, 209
- Advanced Certificate - 11 Courses (46 credit hours) : All AUTOTEC Courses
- Associates in Applied Science - 18 Courses (66 credit hours): All AUTOTEC Courses and 7 General Education Courses

## DIESEL TECHNOLOGY

### ASSOCIATE DEGREE | CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS

The Diesel Technology Basic Certificate Programs equip students with the skills necessary to repair and maintain diesel-powered highway, industrial and marine vehicles and equipment. The Basic Certificate Program provides students with entry-level skills to enter the medium/ heavy duty or construction equipment service repair fields. The Advanced Certificate program is heavily focused on diesel engines performance, hydraulics, electrical, air conditioning, and drive trains. The AAS Program highlights diesel service management, critical thinking and problem solving, theory and skills of refrigeration, electronic and mechanical fuel injection, chassis maintenance, vehicle inspection, tune-up, engine overhaul, transmission repair, brake service and handling hazardous waste and preventative maintenance.

### PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

Olive-Harvey College's Diesel Technology Program consists of a Basic Certificate, Advanced Certificate and Associate Degree Programs. Eligibility for English 101 and Math 90 or 98 are required. High school diploma or GED required. Must be at least 18 years old at the time of registration.

- Basic Certificate – 6 Courses (20 credit hours): DIESEL 111, 113, 112, 114, 115 and 1 General Education Course
- Advanced Certificate - 16 Courses (50 credit hours) : All DIESEL Courses and 3 General Education Courses
- Associates in Applied Science – 25 Courses (70 credit hours): All DIESEL Courses and 8 General Education Courses

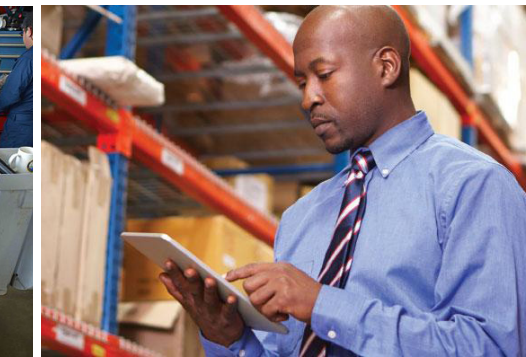

## SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT AND LOGISTICS

### ASSOCIATE DEGREE | CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS

The Transportation, Distribution & Logistics program provides students with a direct experience working in a logistics environment, building skills critical to success including: operations/ business development, receiving, shipping, and case analysis. The program prepares students for working from entry level to supervisory positions. Students will receive three semesters of practical logistics operations experience, working at the college's on-site distribution center, the "Central Store."

### PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

Olive-Harvey College's Supply Chain Management and Logistics Program consists of a Basic Certificate, Advanced Certificate and Associate Degree Programs. High school diploma or GED required.

- Basic Certificate – 5 Courses (15 credit hours): SCML150, 152, 154, 155, 115 and 158
- Advanced Certificate - 16 Courses (30 credit hours) : All SCML Courses and 1 General Education Course
- Associates in Applied Science – 32 Courses (60 credit hours): All SCML Courses, and Business and General Education Courses
